CODE OF CONDUCT Motorcycle Scavenger Hunt

Participation in the Motorcycle Scavenger Hunt (“Event”) hosted by EMS RoadDocs RC (“Organizer”), and those associated with the EMS RoadDocs RC, is a privilege, not a right. By registering for or participating in the Event, participants agree to comply with this Code of Conduct.

1. Compliance With Laws
 - a. Participants must comply with all local, state, and federal laws, including traffic laws, safety equipment requirements, and trespassing laws.
2. Safety and Riding Conduct
 - a. Participants must ride responsibly and defensively. The Event is not a race. Reckless, aggressive, or unsafe riding behavior will result in disqualification.
3. Access and Property Respect
 - a. Participants may only access publicly available locations. Trespassing or entry into restricted or private property is prohibited.
4. Integrity of Submissions
 - a. All submissions must be honest and accurate. Altered photos, digitally added Participant IDs, falsified mileage, or misleading submissions are prohibited.
5. Participant Identification
 - a. Participants must comply with all Participant ID requirements, including physical display of the assigned 4-digit ID in photos.
6. Duplicate Submissions
 - a. Each challenge may be completed once per participant unless otherwise stated. Duplicate submissions receive zero points.
7. Behavior Toward Others
 - a. Participants must treat other participants, judges, volunteers, and the public with respect. Harassment, threats, or abusive conduct will not be tolerated.
8. Alcohol, Drugs, and Impairment
 - a. Operating a motorcycle while impaired by alcohol, drugs, or other substances is strictly prohibited.
9. Online and Social Media Conduct
 - a. Participants are expected to behave responsibly in online spaces related to the Event. Harassment or misrepresentation of the Event may result in disqualification.
10. Cooperation With Organizers
 - a. Participants must cooperate with reasonable requests from organizers or judges. Failure to cooperate may result in rejection of submissions.
11. Enforcement
 - a. EMS RoadDocs RC reserves the right to take disciplinary action, including warnings, rejection of submissions, or disqualification.
12. No Refunds
 - a. Disqualification for violation of this Code of Conduct results in forfeiture of all entry fees.
13. Organizer Authority
 - a. All decisions by EMS RoadDocs RC regarding enforcement of this Code of Conduct are final.
